- 5. When you've saved the images, the desktop folder will contain a "mini-website", consisting of a pre-formatted HTML page and all the images saved in JPG format. (*For browser compatibility, the JPG format cannot be changed.*) The folder can be zipped and attached to a mail message or copied to CD media.
- 6. On receipt, the customer should double-click on the HTML page to display the exam and its images (see next figure for an example).

Please note that the recipient will need Internet Explorer 5 or higher to view the images inside the Web Viewer's exam page.
